

# MADD launches fund drive

Mothers Against Drunk Driving (MADD) in Michigan has kicked-off its first-ever tele-marketing fund drive to support its increased activities in Michigan.

During the next few months, calls will be made to households in Wayne, Oakland, Macomb, Washtenaw, Livingston, plus Monroe counties requesting tax deductible donations. For such support, MADD will give each donor a dining card featuring two-for-one type discounts

valid in over 80 southeastern Michigan restaurants. The card will be good for one year.

Solicitors making calls are licensed by the state of Michigan for this campaign; they will request that checks or money orders be made out to "MADD-Michigan."

MADD's two basic objectives are to provide emotional support to surviving victims of drunk and drugged driving crashes; and to remove impaired drivers from the road through

increased public awareness, education, and more effective handling of cases in the court system.

MADD's education efforts have included "Project Graduation" for high school students, New Year's "LifeRide" (free taxis), and annual candlelight vigils to remember those killed in alcohol-related crashes.

# WSU labor school registers

Registration for the Labor School at Wayne State University is currently under way, with classes scheduled to begin the week of Sept. 22. Deadline for application is Monday, Sept. 15.

The two-year educational program is designed for working men and women and is free of entrance requirements, grades or examinations.

Coursework includes classes in effective reading, science and technology change, the development of industrial America, American society today, perspectives of American labor, effective writing and the enjoyment of reading.

Classes are scheduled for both mornings and evenings on the WSU campus, Tuesday mornings and evenings at the UAW Local 735 in Canton and Thursday evenings on the University of Michigan-Dearborn campus.

Labor school tuition is \$100 a year. The program is approved for reimbursement by both UAW Ford and GM Training Centers. Scholarship assistance is also available.

First-year students are required to attend a half-day orientation session at 9 a.m. Saturday, Sept. 20, in Room 91 of Manoegean Hall on the WSU campus.

Graduates of the program are automatically admitted to WSU and can receive 10 hours of tuition-free credit if they choose to continue studies in a degree program. Further information may be obtained by contacting the program coordinator, Geraldine Hill, at 577-2197.
