CITY OF FARMINGTON HILLS SUMMARY OF PROCEEDINGS REGULAR CITY COUNCIL PUBLIC HEARING AUGUST 18, 1986

Mayor Alkatieb opened the regular meeting of the Farmington Hills City Council on August 18, 1986 at 7:30 p.m. Members present: Alkatieb, Dolan, Dudley, Sever, and Wolf. Members absent: Soronen and Marks. Others present: City Manager Coslick, City Clerk Reynolds, City Attorney Ribicak.

Discussion was held, with no Council action taken, on PHD Plan 1-1986, for the Copper Creek Development, located between Twelve and Thirteen Mile between Halsted and Haggerty Road.

Council INTRODUCED the following Ordinances:

- Zoning Map Amendment, ZR 21-5-86, to rezone property at 23225 Middlebelt, between 10 and 11 Mile Roads, in the NE 1/4 of Section 23, from RA-1 to RCE.
- Zoning Map Amendment, ZR PC 21-5-86, to rezone property on the West side of Middlebelt, between 10 and 11 Mile Roads, in the NE 1/4 of Section 23, from RA-1 to RCE.
- Zoning Map Amendment, ZR 23-5-86, to rezone property on the east side of Middlebelt and south of Ten Mile in the NW 1/4 of Section 25, from RA-1 to RCE.
- Zoning Map Amendment, ZR 23-5-86, to rezone property on the West side of Middlebelt, between Belfast and Eldred, in the SE 1/4 of Section 35, from RA-3 to CG-1.

Council took no action relative Zoning Map Amendment, ZR 21-5-86, for property on the southeast corner of Eleven Mile and Middlebelt in the NE 1/4 of Section 23. This rezoning request was sent back to Planning Commission for further consideration.

Council approved Cluster Site Plan 72-86, located on the East side of Middlebelt, south of Fourteen Mile, in the NW 1/4 of Section 1, for a Cluster Development in RA-1 with 10 units.

Consideration of Revised Open Space Plan for Green Valley Estates Subdivision located at the southeast corner of Nine Mile and Halsted in the NW 1/4 of Section 23 was withdrawn from the Agenda.

Council approved the vacation of Davis Lane in Section 12.

Council ENACTED Ordinance No. C-35-86, for Transfer of Land with Hunters Pointe Subdivision and the Historic District.

Council ENACTED Ordinance No. C-34-86, for sale of land of Lots 20 and 21, Section P of Farmington Heights Subdivision in Section 2.

Meeting adjourned at 10:20 p.m.
