Council will consider enactment of the following zoning ordinances:

- To rezone property on the west side of Orchard Lake, between Firwood and Ravine from RA-1 to OS-3.
- To rezone acreage on the south side of Nine Mile, east and west of Drake Road from RA-1 and RA-3 to RP-2.
- To rezone land on the south side of Nine Mile, east of Green Hill Road from RA-1 to RP-2.
- To rezone property on the north side of Ludden, east of Orchard Lake from RA-4 to OS-1.

Council will also consider a tax abatement request from Jonna Realty Enterprises.
