

police/fire calls

Listed below are some of the Farmington-area police and fire calls received during the past week.

STATION ROBBED

A man who implied he had a gun robbed the Union 76, 29510 Orchard Lake, of \$150 Sept. 19.

According to a Farmington Hills police report:
At 11:30 p.m., a man in his early 30s took a bottle of pop from the cooler and approached the counter. When the clerk said, "60 cents," the man placed his gym bag on the counter, unzipped it, reached inside and said, "plus what you have in the register," implying a stickup. After receiving money and ordering the attendant into a back room, the man left.

ELECTRICAL FIRE

Two electricians were injured when an electrical room panel being worked on short-circuited at United Savings Bank, 31731 Northwestern, Sept. 20.

Electrical damage was estimated at \$7,500.

One worker was overcome by fumes from burning insulation. Smoke and sparks trapped him inside an elevator room for about 15 minutes.

Another worker received a slight arm burn.

There was smoke damage throughout the second floor and the atrium. Flame damage was confined to the electrical panel and the out-

side electrical service, said Lt. Peter Baldwin of the Farmington Hills Fire Department.

LIGHTNING STRIKES

Damage was estimated at \$30,000 when lightning struck a house on Country Ridge Circle during a thunderstorm the night of Sept. 22.

The homeowner was watching television when lightning struck the roof. Smelling smoke, he led his family outside and called the fire department.

Firefighters found flames in the attic and extinguished them, according to a Farmington Hills Fire Department report.

INDECENT EXPOSURE

A man standing near Power at the north end of Shilohwase Park exposed himself Sept. 22 to two Farmington High School students, who were running through the park for track practice, according to a Farmington Department of Public Safety report.

The two 15-year-olds noticed the man standing near bushes next to the track.

The man's description matched that given by witnesses in several other indecent exposure incidents in the city during the past year. The man left the park on a 10-speed bicycle, according to the public safety report.

SUSPECT NABBED

A 32-year-old Detroit man wanted on a felony warrant on charges of

assault with intent to commit murder was arrested while driving through Farmington Sept. 18, according to a Farmington Department of Public Safety report.

The man was captured on Grand River when stopped for driving 50 in a 35 mph zone, according to the public safety report. The felony warrant was issued in Detroit April 2.
