leisuretime diversions as a Jack Nicklaus golf course, jogging trails and both indoor and outdoor sporting facilities. This fall, guests can also enjoy panoramic views, elegant dining and luxurious suites in the resort's recently opened 17-story tower which features 25 shops and the top floor Trillium restaurant and nightclub.

Golf enthusiasts can enjoy the season at a variety of challenging courses. Jack Nicklaus's "The Bear" at the Grand Traverse Resort and Arnold Palmer's "The Legend" at Hilton Shanty Creek in Bellaire are just two of the courses which have earned the region the reputation as the Gold Coast of the Midwest. Professional golfer Jan Stephenson makes Sugar Loaf Resort a regular stop and, as the resort's touring golf professional, often participates in classes and workshops there. Crystal Mountain in Thompsonville and Schuss Mountain in Mancelona also feature extensive golf facilities.

For visitors with a more adventurous bent, over 20 state parks and private campgrounds operate throughout the Grand Traverse region. The Department of Natural Resources operates the Leelanau State Park in Northport, the Interlochen State Park and the Traverse City State Park year-round. Private campgrounds like Jellystone Park in Traverse City are located throughout the five-county area.

Bed and breakfast lodging offers another vacation alternative. Charming establishments like the antique-filled Warwickshire Inn, Traverse City's first bed and breakfast, are dotted throughout the region offering a relaxed atmosphere, personalized attention and family-like camaraderie among the guests. Many are located in picturesque settings, just steps away from colorful nature walks and views. Approximately 17 bed and breakfasts operate in the Grand Traverse region.

Private cottages are also an option for autumn visitors. Many full housekeeping cottages are available during fall and winter by private owners and small resorts. Both daily and weekly rates are available for one to three bedroom cottages. Accommodations are usually located on the water or have water access and often include a rowboat. Additional

Reservation aid

Visitors to the Grand Traverse region can take advantage of Michigan Reservation Service & Vacation Planning (MI-RSVP), the area's only centralized accommodation reservation service. Located in downtown Traverse City, MI-RSVP is a private enterprise representing a variety of hotels, motels, cottages, resorts and bed & breakfast establishments subscribing to the service.

Area visitors can use MI-RSVP free of charge by calling the office at (616) 947-1166. MI-RSVP will make arrangements and confirm your reservation at the time of the call. Fall and winter hours are 9:30 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday.

amenities vary by facility but can include outdoor grills, picnic tables, playgrounds and larger boat rentals. Michigan-RSVP, (616) 947-1166, maintains a centralized listing of rental cottages throughout the region.

When mixing business with pleasure is a priority, the Grand Traverse Convention and Tourist Bureau can help coordinate needs. Meeting rooms, private party rooms and convention facilities are provided by at least a quarter of the bureau's member properties. These facilities often offer special group rate packages for business or large social gatherings. In addition, the bureau will provide information packets on special tours, shopping, points of interest, entertainment and cultural spots in the area for visiting groups.

New construction and renovation of existing lodging facilities has increased the number of available accommodations during the past summer, and will continue to do so in the months ahead. The Traverse Bay Inn, opened since Memorial Day, features 20 motel room/apartments equipped with living room, kitchen and bedrooms. The Waterfront Inn recently opened a new convention complex and the Best Western Four Seasons has renovated and expanded its facilities to include many new amenities. The Hampton Inn is slated for opening in December, a Knights Inn is under construction and the Bayshore project is under development.
