HE PAINTINGS of P. Buck-ley Moss draw the viewer into a peaceful world filled with gentle people and

"I don't do anything to order," explained the 33-year-old artist. "I have to be inspired. If Tm Inspired, I will do it. Moss, who likes to be called Pat, grow up on Staten Island, NLY. Often the backdrop is stark, windswept or snow-covered.

"She has a strong following here," said Alvin Larson of the Frame Works. "We've drawn people (customers) from the western suburbs, Rochester and Birmingham."




