'Janus' Is Chosen By Wayne Players

"Janus," the comedy by Carolyn Green which was one of the major successes of Broadway during the 1955-56 season, has been chosen as the next play to be presented by the Wayne City Players.

The comedy will be presented Friday and Saturday, Oct. 23 and 24 at 8:30 p.m. and Sunday, Oct. 25 at 7:30 p.m. in John Glenn High School, Westland.

"Janus" is being directed by Bob Wagner, assisted by Karen Anderson.

The play is a farce-comedy about a love-triangle with the new twist that the Internal Revenue Dept. pokes its inquisitive nose into the situation.

The revenue agent, played by Floyd Guernsey, doesn't intend to snoot into the amorous aspects of the secret meeting each summer in New York of a woman from Seattle and a professor from a Massachusetts prep school.

Millie Roy plays the respectable and wealthy lady from Seattle, and Bob Gregory is the teacher.

Carl Schuman plays the husband who finds out about the summer project. The cast also includes Ginnie Tadlock as Miss Abby.

Choral Unit Featured

Planiest Evelyn Crochet, whose musical achievements include a first prize from the Paris Conservatory and a celebrated U.S. debut with the Boston Symphony Orchestra, and violinist Nathan Gordon, who came to the Detroit Symphony from Toscanini's NBC Symphony, will have solo roles at the Detroit Symphony Orchestra 71st and 72nd annual concerts, Oct. 15 and 17.

Sixteen Ehring will conduct both performances, scheduled for 8:30 p.m. in Ford Auditorium.

The program, which will be the same on both nights, also will include 100 members of the University of Michigan Choral Union in that organization's first participation in a Detroit Symphony concert.

Miss Crochet and the chorus will be featured in Beethoven's seldom heard Choral Fantasy, written for piano, chorus and orchestra. This will be the first time the Detroit Symphony has performed the work.

Nathan Gordon will be the soloist in the Handel Concerto for Viola and Orchestra in B minor.

Ehring also will conduct the overture to Rossini's opera "Semiramide" and Igor Stravinsky's Symphony in Three Movements.
