Auto layoffs hike state joblessness

Michigan's jobless rate is up 0.7 percent to 3.9 percent.
Temporary layoffs in several of the state's auto plants and a decline in farm employment pushed up the easonally adjusted unemployment rate in September, sald Michigan Employment Security Commission Director Richard Simmons Jr.
Production adjustments caused the short-term auto industry layoffs, most of which lasted for only one or two weeks, Simmons sald.

THE STATE is experiencing a drop in agricultural employment because of the heavy rains and flooding which began striking mid-Michigan Sept. 10. As a result, agricultural workers have become eligible for Tederal disaster unemployment assistance.

federal disaster unemployment as-sistance.
According to the labor force esti-mates that were prepared by the U.S. Burcau of Labor Statistics, Michigan's jobless total climbed by 35,000 in September to 391,000. In August 356,000 workers, or 8.2 per-cent of the state's labor force, were anemployed.
In September Michigan's labor force grew by 21,000 to 4,369,000. Ifotal employment declined by 74,000 to 3,978,000.

THE STATE'S September jobless rate is at its lowest level for the month since 1979 when it was 8.2

month since 1979 when it was 8.2 occeed.

It still is well below the rate of a year ago. In September 1985, Michigan's unemployment rate was 10.6 occeed with 480,000 out of work.

Simmons pointed out that the improvement in Michigan's year-to-year unemployment rate is a sign of the steady improvement in Michigan's economy, Monthly unemployment rates have remained below their year-ago levels since July 1982.
