County lawyer cool to anti-drug ordinance

A splash of cool water from a law-yer won't stop two Oakland County commissioners from seeking pas-sage of an ordinance banning sale of

"This is too serious for politics," said Commissioner James Doyon, D-Madison Heights, on the election-eve holdup of the anti-drug measure Doyon, whose district includes part of Troy, is a co-sponsor.

He said other sponsor Betty Fortino, D-Waterford, will seek to district include meeting to move the proposal out of the general government committee.

"That committee hasn't even met recently," said Doyon. "They say there isn't enough business to warrant calling a meeting."

national ardinances were challenged in two cases on basically the same grounds," she said, citing:

• A 1980 Novi case in which then Federal Judge Patricia Boyle "upheid the validity of the ordinance as reasonably related to a legitimate state interest and not unconstitutionally vague."

state interest and not unconstitution-nily vague."

• A 1980 Ferndale case, in which Federal Judge Anna Diggs Taylor "struck the ordinance down as in vi-olation of due process in that it did not give fair notice to persons of or-cinced conduct."

She said such an ordinance would be upheld as long as there was no state law on the subject, and that it would not interfere with the powers of cities and townships.

THE STATE Senate has passed a bill to prohibit the sale of drug paraphernalia, but it is not due for House action until after the Nov. 4 election. Fortino and Doyon say a county ordinance would put pressure on the Legislature to pass a law with state-wide application.

Doyon sald Gov. James J. Blanchard has some commitment to the measure.

The governor must sign county ordinances, the same as state laws, though the county board could override any veto by a two-thirds vote.
