Arthritic youth invited to class

The problems of living with arthritis are challenging at any age, but this condition can be especially tough for children.

As many as 250,000 American children have some form of arthritis. This figure alone should dispel the stereotyped notion that arthritis is a disease of old age.

The parents of a child with arthritis soon becomes the primary care-giver and, as such, needs to be equipped with knowledge and understanding of arthritis and how to manage it.

The Arthritis Foundation is offering, for the first time, an arthritis

self help course directed toward parents and older teenagers. The six week class provides education about arthritis, treatments, exercise, relaxation, medication and joint protection. The course encourages group participation and mutual support between participants.

Yogaday coming up

Participants, novices or advanced students, are offered a choice of 40 classes that will be led by yoga teachers who are members of the sponsoring association.

In addition to traditional yoga sessions, workshops, films and lectures, Yogaday offers sessions on yoga-related subjects, such as nutrition, massage, meditation, breathing and relaxation techniques.

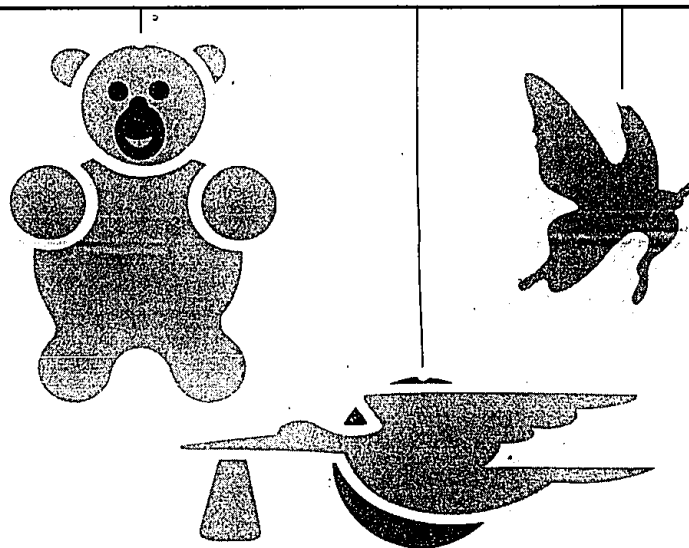
