**JOHANNES SPREEN ASKS —**  
**DO YOU KNOW WHO YOUR COUNTY COMMISSIONER IS?**  
**IF YOU DO - DO YOU KNOW WHAT HE HAS DONE?**

Dear Neighbor,

**My name is Johannes Spreen and I hope to be your next County Commissioner.**

Some of you know me as your Sheriff. During my 12 years in office there were many accomplishments, including:

- Prisoner pick up and delivery (Keeps local police on neighborhood patrol)
- First Alcohol Enforcement Team in State (With mobile breathalyzers)
- Utilization of inmate labor (For clean-up projects and beautification work)
- S.C.A.T. (Sheriff's Criminal Annoyance Team) — forerunner of nationally acclaimed R.O.P. (Repeat Offenders Project) as seen on CBS "60 Minutes"
- First Sheriff in Nation with Victim-Witness Program and with "McGruff" (Take A Bite Out Of Crime)
- County-wide crime prevention patrols (Reserves and Volunteers - at no cost)

Some of you may know me as Police Commissioner of the City of Detroit in 1968 and 1969. Among my accomplishments and innovations were:

- Establishment of scooter patrols in 1968 (Still in effect in Detroit, New York and Washington, D.C.)
- "Buck Up Your Police" program (Citizen involvement and assistance)
- Public Information Center (For timely and proper information to citizens)

Before I came to Michigan in 1968, I served 25 years in the New York City Police Dept., coming up through all competitive ranks at the top of all civil service lists.

In between, I achieved two college degrees: B.S. in Police Science and Masters degree in Public Administration. I am presently working toward my Ph.D. degree in Educational Sociology.

Now that I have retired from Law Enforcement, I would like very much to serve as your County Commissioner. Some of the reasons I am running are:

- Belief in county government and its growing importance in the future.
- Importance of regional (county-wide) approach to our common problems e.g.: Waste disposal, infrastructure, drunk driving, crime and accident control.
- Belief in the people of my community and belief in myself.

Some of the things I would like to do are:

- See that better principles of management are followed.
- Stop the waste of citizens money, caused by poor planning.
- Meet monthly with those citizens of my district who wish to.
- Establishment of county-wide traffic coordination and traffic patrols.
- Give full time attention to this part time position.
