NEARSIGHTED

Nearsightedness is inherited and is dominant over other forms of vision. It affects only your distant vision. Children who are nearsighted become progressively nearsighted as they grow. Children who are nearsighted are born with long eyes. As the child grows the eye grows. Therefore, it is important that nearsighted children be examined every year and in some instances more often. When a child obtains full growth, nearsightedness normally stops progressing.

Nearsighted glasses tend to be very thick at the edge and thin in the center. In accidents the lens tends to break inward toward the eye. It is safer to wear plastic lenses in nearsighted glasses. Plastic lenses may scratch easier, but break very seldom. Contact lenses may also be used to correct nearsightedness and are very important in severe nearsightedness.

Recently, surgery has been advocated to treat nearsightedness. One operation imported from Russia, has been performed over 200,000 times in the United States. A second operation has been imported from South America but has only been done by a select few, highly skilled surgeons, on a limited number of patients. A third operation was developed here in the United States and is gaining more popularity. It has the unique characteristic of being reversible if the patient doesn't like it.

Some patients have enjoyed the results of surgery but others have continuing problems many months later. Because of the demand to get rid of glasses, a more satisfactory surgical procedure will probably evolve in the future.

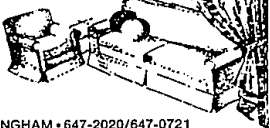
