## Bid to save Bootleggers over

On Oct. 15, the Michigan Liquor Control Commission permanently cancelled the bar's liquor license, previously held in escrow by the bar's parent company, Pal Joey's, Inc., which is owned by loughtme bar owner Joe Ascione.

The license also included a dance permit and allowed Sunday liquor sales for the bar, at the corner of Grand River and Brookdale. "Absent such an approval, the license is precluded from transferring and/or reactivating the subject licensed business," the decision said.
