dinance. "We should table this until the state Legislature has a chance to act on a similar bill," said Commissioner John Olsen, R-Huntington Woods, whose general government committee reported out the ordinance over ble phiseline.

bring the ordinance back," Olsen said as he proposed tabling the measure indefinitely.
Seventeen Republicans voted for tabling, and seven Democrats were opposed. Tabling effectively kills a proposal, although later reconsideration is possible.

"A STATEWIDE law is prefera-ile," admitted Commissioner James Joyon, D-Madison Heights, a co-ponsor of the ordinance. But he said
