Abduction try averted

With assistance from a Farmington Hills resident, police arrested an 18-year-old Detroit who allegedly led officers on a chase through five communities.
The chase ended when the suspect allegedly jumped into a car containing a woman and an infant and attempted to drive away.
The woman's husband had left the car in a driveway at Orchard Creek Apartments in Farmington Hills with the motor running while he went to his mailbox. His wife and child remained in the car. The suspect, meanwhile, abandoned the car he was driving and jumped into the driver's seat of the resident's car.
The resident ran to his car, yanked the door open and pulled the suspect out, holding him until police arrived, officers reported.
Michael Joseph Sarappa of De-

troit was arraigned in 47th District Court in Farmington on charges of attempted kidnapping and attempting to unlawfully drive away an automobile, both felonies. He stood mute and innocent pleas were entered on his behalf.
He was also arraigned in 48th District Court in Bloomfield Township on felony charges of malicious destruction of property over \$100, receiving and concealing stolen property and unlawfully driving away an automobile and a misdemeanor charge of failure to obey a police officer's command to stop. He stood mute to those charges and innocent pleas were entered.
Bond was set at \$5,000 following each of the arraignments for a total of \$10,000.

POLICE SAID the chase started about 10 p.m. Nov. 8 after an offi-

cer on his way to work in Keego Harbor saw a car go off the road and hit a motorcycle parked on a sidewalk at Bloomfield on the Green Apartments.
The driver left the scene, resulting in a chase involving police from Keego Harbor, Sylvan Lake, Orchard Lake and West Bloomfield.

The pursuit ended about 11 p.m. at Orchard Creek Apartments in Farmington Hills.
Police said they believe the man they were chasing abandoned the car he was in when it became stuck in a ditch south of the apartment complex. The car, a 1984 Pontiac 6000, was reported stolen from Waterford Township.
