About 18,000 abortions are performed at a cost of \$6 million annually in Michigan. Both "pro-life" and "pro-choice" factions believe that even with a Medicald abortion ban, 75 to 80 percent of abortions would continue because other funding sources would be found.

The bans on Medicaid abortions, as passed by the Legilature, would affect only operating procedures, not abortion aftercore.




