Car overturns

Listed below are some of the Farmington-area police and fire calls received during the past week.

ROBBERY SUSPECTS

Three Pontiac residents were arrested after an undercover officer on patrol saw two men break into the Speedway station at 14 Mile and Haggerty in Novi, then leave in a car driven by a woman, Farmington Hills police said.

About \$2,100 worth of cigarettes allegedly were stolen from the gas station. After a car chase, the three were arrested and turned over to Novi police. The men were ages 42 and 31. The woman was 30, police said.

According to a Farmington Hills police report:

Sgt. Al Havner was patrolling in the 14 Mile-Haggerty area about 12:45 a.m. when he spotted a dark car pull into the Speedway station, stop by the front door and dim its lights.

The car was soon re-started and its lights were brightened. Two men then got out, broke the door glass and entered the station. Within seconds, they emerged with white plastic bags, later determined to be filled with cartons of cigarettes.

The men threw the bags into the

waiting car, which left south on Haggerty. At Hills Tech Drive, the woman driver allegedly sped up to avoid a marked patrol car trying to stop her.

The driver pulled onto the shoulder to go around the patrol car, but as she tried to get back onto the road, her car struck the patrol car's fender.

The woman then lost control of her car, which skidded head-on into Havner's southbound unmarked car. The collision sent her car off the road. The three occupants were arrested as they tried to leave on foot, according to the police report.

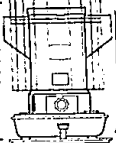

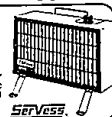
