

# Lung association unveils cash goal

The American Lung Association of Southeast Michigan has announced a goal of \$800,000 for the 1986 Christmas Seal Campaign, according to Rod Burton, association president.

More than 40 million homes across the United States — 837,000 in the Detroit area — have already received the familiar Christmas stamps and soon they will be seen on holiday cards and greetings everywhere.

"The Christmas Seal Campaign represents the spirit of giving and helping others, as well as the American Lung Association's crusade to eliminate such diseases as lung cancer, emphysema, asthma, chronic bronchitis and tuberculosis," Burton said.

This marks the 79th year of the Christmas Seal tradition. The colorful holiday stamps first appeared in 1907 as an attempt to save one small tuberculosis hospital and have since grown into a holiday tradition as widespread as gifts under the tree.

Today the 139 affiliated Lung Associations throughout the country are dedicated to eradicating all lung disease through research, education, and promotion of a smoke-free America.

Burton, recently elected to president of the Detroit-area Lung Association board, is vice president of retail advertising at J. Walter Thompson Advertising Agency.
