

# Historic museum spruced

As the holiday season comes again to the Farmington area, the Farmington Historical Museum wears its holiday appearance.

Through the generosity of the Springbrook Florists, Michele Marc's Florist and the Village Green Florist, many of the rooms are adorned with floral arrangements. Other rooms and areas are trimmed in the traditional manner through the use of cedar roping, colorful bows, Christmas trees decorated with handmade ornaments typical of a bygone era, a dining room table complete with the touches of holiday splendor.

The children's room is inhabited with dolls of various sizes and shapes, and of materials that range from cloth to porcelain.

One of the upper display areas has a specialized display through the courtesy of the Quakertown Quarters.

The exterior appearance of the former Warner residence shows the holiday touch by the use of greenery and colorful bows. Each window again is lit by a single candle to enhance the darkening hours. The gazebo is again resplendent with the lighted tree through the efforts of the Farmington Jaycees for their second annual tree lighting ceremony, which takes place at 7:30 p.m. Sunday.

To allow additional opportunities for visiting the museum, there will be extended hours this season. On the opening day, Sunday, Dec. 7, the hours are 1-9 p.m., then on Sunday, Dec. 14, the Carillon Choir from the Farmington Methodist Church will fill the museum with bell tones. The museum will be open as normal on Wednesday, Dec. 10 and 17, but will be closed Wednesday, Dec. 24 and 31.

The normal admission of a \$1 donation will be in effect.

## Battling a killer

Farmington Hills Police Chief William Dwyer was one of several civic, community and business leaders handcuffed and jailed at the first Cystic Fibrosis (CF) Lock Up Nov. 21 at the Grand River-Hilsted Shopping Plaza.

The posted bail for each prisoner was earmarked for CF Foundation. Proceeds from the Lock Up will go toward research of cystic fibrosis, the leading genetic killer of children and young adults.
