## County park fees up for '87

The Oakland County Parks and Recreation Commission adopted a budget of nearly \$5 million for 1987. Some fees will be increased.

The operating budget for 1987 is \$5.1 million, and \$1.7 million is available for capital projects.

"With the Red Oaks Waterpark in Madison Heights ready to open this summer, the commission will direct its efforts toward new projects," said Lewis E. Wint, chairman of the parks commission.

PARKS MANAGER Ralph Richard said some parks fees will rise in

ard sald some parks fees will rise in 1987.
"In comparing market rates and surveying other leisure activities, we recommended increases for the wave pools, camping and golf," sald Hichard.

Dally permits at Groveland Oaks near Holly, Addison Oaks near Oxford, and Independence Oaks in Clarkston, will increase from \$2.50 per car for residents to \$3. Non-residents will pay \$5 per car, up from \$4.50.

Admission to the Waterford Oaks Wave Pool and Red Oaks Waterpark will be \$5 (from \$4) including use of the watersilides at both facilities.

Fees for modern campsites at Groveland Oaks near Holly and Addison Oaks near Holly and Addison Oaks nerth of Rochester will rise from \$7\$ to \$10 for Oakland County residents (\$12.50 for non-residents) and will include concrete pad, water and electricity.

Golf greens fees for Oakland County residents at Glen Oaks in Parmington Hills, White Lake Oaks near Pontlae, and Springfield Oaks in Davisburg will rise from \$5.50 to \$5.75 for nine boles and from \$9 to \$5.75 for nine boles and from \$9 to \$5.50 for line boles.

Some \$3.6 million will come from fees and charges. Nearly \$4.4 million will be generated from a 0.25 mill property tax for county parks (25 cents per \$1,000 of state equalized valuation) plus interest on investments.

an undeveloped 927-acre park in Orion Township.

• Feening of the 145-acre Waterford Oaks in Waterford Townships.

• Major electrical rewiring of the conference center and expansion of cross-country ski traits (including a two mile lighted trail) at Addison Oaks, north of Rochester.

• 48 new campsites at Groveland Oaks near Holly with matching state grant funds. • Cart path improvements and tee markers for the golf-courses in-cluding Glen Oaks in Farmington hills, Springlield Oaks in Davisburg, White Lake Oaks near Pontiac, and Red Oaks in Madison Heights. • Construction of a parks and recreation administration office building at5 Waterford Oaks in Waterford Township.


