

If you notice a car following you into your subdivision and acting suspiciously, don't stop at your house. "Proceed to a public area and call the police. Don't create an opportunity to be assaulted or robbed," when you have the car, identify the occupants and determine what their business in the area is."

SINCE MOST of the thefts oc-curred after dark, Nebus suggests assuring your house has adequate outside lighting to act as a deterrent. He also suggests locking your garage door as well as the entry door to your bouse after arriving hour "And don't leave valuables inside your car, even if it's locked."

Be extra cautious about someone knocking on your door or ringing your bell minutes after you arrive home, he added.

Similar purse snatchings have been reported in recent weeks in other area communities, including Livonia, Franklin and Southfield. "It's a new trend that's not just hap-pening here," Nebus said.
