"But we've already done field testing." Rochford said, "And both tested positive. A positive field test is enough to get a warrant on."

Doa appealed her conviction and sentence, which included five years probation and a six-month jail sentence. Lipplit allowed Doa to remain free pending her appeal, though she did begin serving her probation. She gave birth to a baby boy in mid-No-wember.


