During this public hearing, commissioners will review the following:

- Zoning request: North of 10 Mile, east of Orchard Lake Road. From RA-1 to RA-3. Proponent is James S. Burroughes. Owner is Orchard-10 Associates.
- Zoning request: South side of 12 Mile, east of Orchard Lake Road. From RA-2 and OS-1 to B-3 and OS-4. Proponent is Robert A. Dykstra.
- Zoning request: East side of Haggerty, north of 12 Mile. From RA-1 to RCE. Proponent is Ellen Parker, Juel Inc. Owners are Corrine Kobe, George and Adele De-nomme and Hope Lutheran Church.
- Zoning Text Amendment — This proposed amendment will amend the section of the zoning ordinance with respect to non-profit schools.

• Zoning Text Amendment — Frontage options. This proposed amendment would give notice of public hearing in accordance with Section 60.2611.

• Zoning Text Amendment — Height limit. This proposed amendment would allow skylights to exceed the maximum height limit with conditions and amend the cupola standards.

A public hearing regarding the building at 33330 Thomas Street continues. The city has deemed the building dangerous under nuisance ordinance and gave the owner 30 days to comply with code violations.

Also on the agenda is consideration of an appointment of a deputy treasurer.

A planning commission recommendation to rezone Lot 15, Assessor's Plat No. 4 from R-5 Deluxe Multi-family to R-1-0 One Family Office, located immediately west of the Oakwood Cemetery on the north side of Grand River, will also be considered.

A proposed alarm system for the Farmington Historical Museum, cost agreement for installation of the traffic signal at Grand River and Grove and installation of a road edge drain will also be discussed by the council.

A progress report on the Enhanced 9-1-1 county emergency telephone program will also be given by administration.

Correspondence regarding several liquor control matters, a financial report from the General Fund and 47th District Court, and contractor payments are also slated for council action tonight.

Adoption of amendments to the city's alarm ordinance and parking control on Raphael Street are also on the agenda.

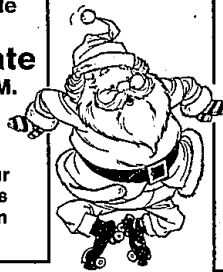
