## Illicit spas targeted by new city ordinance

Only myomassologists, with irrent city permits, shall perform

No portion of the employee's body which might arouse customers can be exposed, including breasts, buttocks and genital areas.

At all times, customer's genital

At all times, customer's genital areas must be covered with towels,

areas must be covered with towels, cloths or undergarments.

• Customers must be at least 18 years old, and the spas cannot be open between 11 p.m. and 7 a.m.

ALSO, THE ORDINANCE requires that spa employees cannot live at the business address. Fasbinders add massage parlor employees have often lived at establishments where suspected illicit activities have taken place.

Ordinance violators, if convicted, would face maximum penaltics of 9 days in fall and/or a \$500 fine.

The constitutionality of ordinances similar to the one recently enacted in Southfield is now being challenged in court. Fasbinder noted.

Brandishing a hunting knile with a 6-inch blade, the man demanded that the woman hand over her purse and fled the scene. The victim was not injured, Conat said.


