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Kalkaska County Kalkaska Historical Museum

Displays include the Elmer, an all hand-made, hand-tooled automobile, one of three ever made; photographs of area residents in Civil War times, muskets, clothing, and an old wood-working plant.

The museum, located at 346-347 Cedar St., Kalkaska opens in June, daily except Sunday, noon to 4 p.m.

Leelanau County Leelanau Historical Museum

The new museum opened in the summer

of 1985 and houses a complete collection of artifacts, historical clothing and photos detailing early pioneer days in Leelanau county. The museum is located at the foot of Cedar St., Leland, on the Leland River.

Sleeping Bear Dunes National Lakeshore Maritime Museum

U.S. Lifesaving and Coast Guard exhibits, shipping and shipwrecks of the Manitou Passage, artifacts from wrecks, restored boathouse with replica of a 1910 vintage surf-boat, 26-foot style B.B. McLellan, built in Camden, Maine.

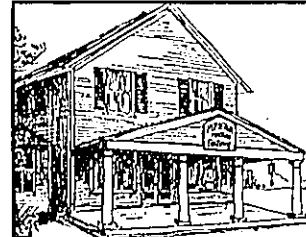
On Route 269 east of Glen Arbor at

Sleeping Bear Point, it is open daily beginning in mid-May through Labor Day.

"Remembering Empire" Museum

Operated by the Empire Heritage Group at the old Empire fire station and village hall behind the Glen Lake Community Library on Front St., the museum features a collection of historic artifacts from the Empire area.

A new, two-story museum will be completed by this summer, and will feature a complete replica of a 1900 Empire saloon. It is located adjacent to the new Empire fire hall.



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
