ANN ARBOR. The University of Michigan Gilbert and Sullivan Society will present "The Yeomen of the Guard" Nov. 11 to 14 in the Lydia Mendelssohn Theatre in Ann Arbor.

Performances are at 8 p.m. Wednesday through Saturday with a Saturday matinee at 2 p.m. Tickets are \$2.50 for the evening performances and \$2 for the matinee. The Mendelssohn box office, located in the Women's League on the U-M central campus, opens Sunday, Nov. 8. Telephone number of the box office is 668-5408 and of the society is 663-5408.

In selecting "Yeomen of the Guard," the society now in its 24th year, is presenting the team's only serious opera. A thoroughgoing tragedy, it is said to be more of an outgrowth of Gilbert's personal aspirations after serious theater and Sullivan's after grand opera.

"Yeomen" was the 11th of Gilbert and Sullivan's operas and its premiere in October 1888, was an instant success. For the first time, Gilbert was

Ustinov's comedy is a reverse twist on the generation gap. It is a story of the retired general who embraces the "long-haired cult."

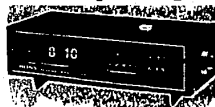
Performances are scheduled for the last two weekends of November and the first weekend in December, in the Players' Barn, 12 Mile between Orchard Lake and Farmington Rds.

Snow Machine Being Readied

A new and bigger snow machine has been moved into place at Alpine Valley Ski area in Milford. It replaces the compressor destroyed by fire Sept. 2.

David DelPiere, Alpine manager, reports the compressor will be ready for the start of the ski season in mid-December. The new compressor has a capacity of 15,000 cubic feet per minute, twice that of the unit destroyed in the fire. Resort owners, Joseph F. Kosik and Willis Stoick, say this means that, given proper weather conditions, a base of two to three feet of snow can be built up within a week.
