Other business includes discussion of a construction schedule for the reconstruction of Pebble Creek Bridge on 12 Mile, west of Inkster, awarding of a contract for paving Halsted Road, between 12 and 14 Mile and discussion of a 1987-88 debt levy as requested by Councilman Donn Wolf.

Discussion of the city's position on the state transportation package, a second assessment for the Caddell Drain, quarterly report from the city's building department and a bond authorization for Michigan Transportation Bonds are also on the agenda.
