The city's most important capital projects are highlighted in Farmington's Stx Year Capital Improvement Program, approved by planning commissioners April 13. The program looks from 1897 though 1992 and was reviewed and discussed by city council members Monday. Proposed projects would be paid for by a variety of bonding proposals and local, state and federal money.

Remaining at the top of the list is the widening of Orchard Lake Road, followed by local street improvements, including those in the Chatham Hills subdivision.

The city's Downtown Development Authority project in the central business district was next in

line, followed by a new storm drain installation on Orchard Lake Road, a 1988 residential sidewalk program on the north side of Grand River and
