
VOLUNTEERS, WHO play big part in hiring the director and co-directors and in checking on operations at the existing center, also are in short supply, Cooley said.
Dolan acknowledged the cost — \$1,500 is budgeted for the existing center this year — but said it's also expensive to have stepped-up polariols along Orchard Lake Road, Farmington Hills' major retail corridor.


