Ridgedale Players ends its 55th season with a winner. Veteran Director Hal Safron serves up Hart-Kaufman's old shoe "You Can't Take It With You" in a production that's a rollicking, slap-happy giggle. This 1940s farce is ideal for amateur theater. A tale of starstruck lovers, the comedy features the ami-

ably dotly Sycamore family, whose peccadillos range from playing the xylophone to evading taxes. Each character is best done broadly and the more ham, the more guffaws. The evening ranges from chuckles to screams, as the large cast of goof-balls bitingly pursues its obsessions. Virtually everyone in the cast deserves applause. Gentle Garner and Don Johannes, as Penelope and Grandpa Vanderhof respectively, are the general linchpins who keep the show running smoothly. They are the solid walls against which the zanies bounce.

Jim Rink's mad Donald is truly inspired. Carmelo Trotto's Mr. DePina is totally plausible. Doris Harforn plays the Grand Duchess with flawless hauteur, and Michael C. Block is winsome as Tony, the beau who loves the nutsoes.
