**NATURE STUDY TOUR** — Farmington-area families may explore the 212-acre park for the signs of spring and wild flowers that inhabit Heritage Park. Tim Nowicki will begin the nature interpretive program with describing the flowers, their growth season, soil and weather conditions required for their existence. The program will be held

from 10 a.m. to noon Saturday, May 16. Fee is \$3 per person or \$7 per family. Pre-registration is required.

**WALK MICHIGAN** — The first of nine "Walk Michigan" events will be held Saturday, May 16, at Heritage Park. You may register in advance at the Recreation Office or 8:30-9 a.m. the day of the event. The walk will be two miles using the trails of the park. Participants in the "Walk Michigan" are eligible for a drawing for a weekend trip for two to Mackinac Island and to participate in the walk across the Mackinac Bridge on Labor Day weekend.

**VOLLEYBALL MEETING** — A general meeting will be held 7 p.m.

Thursday, May 21, in the estate house at Heritage Park. Discussion will be the formation of outdoor volleyball leagues for co-ed and three-man teams. League schedule, entry fee and registration dates will be discussed.

**TIGER BASEBALL** — Travel to Tiger Stadium on Friday, June 12, to see the Tigers take on the Boston Red Sox. Only pre-registration through the Recreation Office by May 22 will be accepted.
