

Mercy president resigns

Mary Naomi Holyk, chair of the Farmington Hills-based Mercy Health Services board of directors, announced the resignation of Mary Kelly, president of the MHS subsidiary, Mercy Services for Aging.

Kelly has been president since the inception of the organization in October 1984.

Noting the contributions of Kelly, Edward Connors, MHS president, said, "Mercy Services for Aging has

a strong foundation within the organization and a strong commitment to the aging populations within the communities we serve. Mary Kelly's leadership has resulted in a capable staff to carry forth the goals of the organization and a governing board equally dedicated to its success."
