Listed are some of the Farmington-area police and fire calls and court cases handled during the past week:

ARMED ROBBERY

Four employees at a fast-food restaurant on Orchard Lake Road in Farmington Hills were robbed at gunpoint May 18.

No one was hurt in the 11:50 p.m. stickup at Taco Bell, 29925 Orchard Lake. No customers were inside at the time. The amount of money taken was not disclosed.

According to the police report: Two men wearing ski masks and armed with handguns ordered one employee onto the floor, a food preparer into the cooler and a dishwasher against a wall. They then ordered the manager to empty the safe and cash register tills into a plastic garbage bag found on a countertop.

The men, thought to be in their 20s, held their guns in a two-handed, combat-type stance during the robbery.

No getaway car was seen.

GUN WAVED

A 34-year-old Detroit woman told police a passenger in a passing car pointed a gun at her as she waited for a traffic light at Eight Mile near Haggerty in Farmington Hills May 14.

The man, thought to be about 18, waved and pointed the gun at her at 10:50 p.m. before the car he was riding in turned off Eight Mile near Haggerty.

The gun was never fired, according to the police report.

Harrison student assaulted

A 17-year-old Harrison High student faces two felony charges in connection with the alleged sexual assault of a 16-year-old student inside a parked van in the school lot at 9:45 a.m. May 15.

Arraigned May 16 before District Judge Margaret Schaeffer of Farmington, Antonio Ivezaj stood mute to single counts of criminal sexual conduct—third degree and assault with intent to commit sexual penetration. Innocent pleas were entered in his behalf.

Ivezaj faces up to 15 years in prison if convicted of the first

count and up to 10 years in prison if convicted of the second count.

He was released on \$1,000 personal recognizance bond pending a preliminary examination in 47th District Court.

The victim was treated at Botsford General Hospital, Farmington Hills.

"We impounded the van and impounded from it evidence that will be sent to the Michigan State Police crime lab for analysis," said Sgt. Charles Nebus of the Farmington Hills Police Department.
