reach or made inaccessible by obstructions" said Harris. "In such cases, the mail would be stamped undeliverable and the customer would have to come to the post office to pick it buy. We need the cooperation of our customers to maintain zervice at its highest level." Postal regulations require that rural and contract route carriers must having to leave their whileles. Such boxes must be on the right-hand side of the road in the carrier's direction of travel where traffic conditions would endanger a carrier driving to the left to reach the boxes. The boxes also must be placed to conform with state laws and highway regulations. Customers are requested to remove obstructions — including vehicles, trasheaus and snow — that make delivery difficult.

For both suburban curbline and rural boxes, the Postal Service requests a height of 3% to 4 feet from

the bottom of the box to ground level. The address should be clearly printed on the receptacle to assure more efficient delivery.

There are approved traditional and contemporary mailbox designs. A customer-designed rural box needs the prior approval of the postmaster before it can be installed. One last safety caution from the

Road projects unveiled
