Hixson At Large

This is the age of anxiety. If Descartes lived today he might say, "I suffer. Therefore I am." The word "anxiety" finds its way with greater frequency on the titles of the latest best seller from Bishop Pike to Paul Tillich. Anxiety is the preoccupation of the existentialists, and while existentialism may be good philosophy, it is poor mental health. On the other hand while positive thinking may be good mental health, it is frequently poor philosophy.

It was Henry David Thoreau who said, "Most men live lives of quiet desperation." But the quiet life of desperation is not so quiet these days. The revolution in the streets is matched by the chaos in our minds.

IN THE FACE OF ANXIETY it is only too easy to regress to old dogmas, conventions, and rituals. It is much more difficult but more constructive to attempt a conscious understanding of the nature of anxiety.

The nature of anxiety is to be found in the nature of change. Psychologists inform us that any change in our environment, even the most minute, causes anxiety. Dostoevsky said that "taking a new step, uttering a new word is what people fear most."

Of change Eric Hoffer writes, "Back in 1936 I spent a good part of the year picking peas. I started out early in January in the Imperial Valley and drifting northward, picking peas as they ripened, until I picked the last peas of the season, in June, around Tracy."

"Then I shifted all the way to Lake County, where for the first time I was going to pick string beans. And I still remember how hesitant I was that first morning as I was about to address myself to the string bean vines. Would I be able to pick string beans had its elements of fear."

If this is the age of anxiety, it is therefore the age of change. Within the span of a decade we have gone from the age of "The True Believer" to the age of "The Restless Believer" to the age of the unbeliever.

Today no affirmation or philosophical proposition is free from its challenges. Situation ethics is a derivative of situation philosophy. And subjectivism in philosophy leads to anarchy in politics.

Our age of anxiety is characterized by a generation of heretics. But the paradox is that the heretics of an age are frequently the heroes of history.

Ford Fund Has 70 Scholarships

Ford Motor Co. will award approximately 70 four-year scholarships in its 19th annual competition, Benson Ford, fund president, has announced.

Winners will be selected by the Ford Fund Scholarship Board after a review of results of each candidate's College Entrance Examination Board scholastic aptitude test, high school performance, personal qualifications and other indications of potential success in college and post-college life.

Information about the Fund's 1968 scholarship program will appear in the Sept. 26 issue of the company newspaper, The Ford World, which will be distributed to all company employees in the United States.
