New Curriculum For Medical Students

A new curriculum of some form is in full operation in 20 North American medical schools, and is being planned in 67 others.

The status of medical cur-

riculum revision, with details filling a book more than an inch thick, was reported re-cently by three University of Michigan medical educators.

They submitted their find-ings to a curriculum workshop sponsored by the Association of American Medical Colleges here.

THE REPORT was based on a survey developed by a steering committee headed by William N, Hubbard Jr., dean of the U-N Medical School and Committee the William N, Hubbard Jr., dean of the U-N Medical School and Constant And Convariant of the U-N Medical School and George R. Debluth, both new associate deans at U-M. They did much of the work while Dr. Growall was associate dean at the University of Mississippi and Dr. Debluth was professor of pediatrics at U-M.

The survey was sent to the dean of each of the 117 medical schools in Canada and the United States, Responses came
