

Abernethy leaves planning post

Longtime Farmington planning commissioner James Abernethy will not serve another three-year term on the commission, it was learned this week. His term expired Monday. The 47-year-old professor of architecture at Southfield's Lawrence Institute of Technology and Farmington resident is also serving the last year of his first, four-year term on the Farmington Board of Education.

Two seats on the planning commission became wacant as of Monday, with the city council appointing Norman Potts to another three-year term expiring in 1990 and leaving Abernethy's seat vacant.
Abernethy has been active in city government for the past 10 years and has served on the commission since Oct. 2, 1978.

ABERNETHY CITED time con-flicts in his community and work responsibilities as his reason for not seeking another term. He said it was "not fair" to the city because

he could not attend many of the meetings.
"It was with a lot of reluctance that I did it," he added.
Abernethy said he will probably continue to serve as a liaison between the school district and the

tween the school district and the city.
During his 20 years as a Farmington resident, Aberenethy has used his talents in other areas. He served on the city's Zoning Board of Appeals and on the architectural review committee of the Farmington Meadows Homeowners Association. He holds a master's degree

in urban planning from Wayne State University. In filling another planning com-mission vacancy recently, Farm-ington Mayor William Hartsock said it's important to appoint peo-ple who represent a cross-section of the community, both geographi-cally and in background.

Interested Farmington residents, plus two applicants for a position filled last September are expected to be considered for Abernethy's

vacant seat.
The previous applicants include

Planning commissioners are ap-pointed by the city council.


