50,000 May Attend 25th Sunday School Meeting

The Rev. Bob Harrington, famed "chaplain of Bourbon Street," and several other widely known in evangelism and Christian education, will head the Michigan Sunday School Assn. Convention that is expected to draw more than 50,000 to Cobo Hall during the weekend of Nov. 12 to 14.

Also scheduled for attendance are Dr. W.A. Criswell, pastor of the First Baptist Church of Dallas, one of the largest in the country; Dr. Jack Van Impe, dynamic young evangelist, Dale Evans, film and television personality, and Tony Fontane, recording artist.

The convention, marking its 25th anniversary and recognized as the largest in the world, also will present special music by a gigantic choir of 1000 children and a 500 teen choral group. A special seminar for young people is scheduled Saturday afternoon.

Cobo Hall was first used as a site in 1967, because the convention had been meeting in various large Detroit churches and turning away thousands.

That year attendance was 20,000. Scheduling difficulties prevented use of the hall the next two years, and Temple Baptist in Redford Township was the scene of the convention last year. Even its large facilities proved inadequate for the more than 35,000 who attended.

This year there are delegates registered from 500 Midwestern and Canadian churches representing 50 denominations.
