

# Herberholz sparks Mercy to victory

Senior forward Jan Herberholz continued to be the catalyst on Farmington Mercy's basketball team Tuesday as the Marlins succeeded in their Catholic League debut.

Herberholz scored 18 points and added six assists as Mercy blushed aside Harper Woods Bishop Gallagher 54-40 on the loser's court.

"Her consistency over the past seven games is an encouraging sign," Mercy coach Larry Baker. "Her passes, her inside play, her ball handling have been outstanding."

"She just played another superlative, all-around game."

The Marlins, 4-3 overall, jumped to an early lead, moving out front 21-14 after one quarter, and that played a major role in establishing a pattern for the night.

"We were excited about getting into a running game," said Baker, adding the Marlins reacted aggressively to Gallagher's press.

Mercy got into foul trouble in the second quarter, but managed to extend its lead to

34-22 at halftime and played the Lancers even in the second half.

Adrienne Clark scored 15 points for the Marlins. Patty Chapp 11 and Jennifer Slosar eight. The latter also had a game-high 16 rebounds. Stacy Kraiza had 15 points for Gallagher.

CANTON 71, FARMINGTON 26: Sometimes there's no in-between in an athletic contest, no gray area, no give and take.

That's how it was Tuesday night when Plymouth Canton belted visiting Farmington.

Everything worked just the way Canton wanted, and nothing went right for the Falcons.

"If I could erase this whole night, I'd be happy," said Farmington coach Diana Fair after her team lost its third straight and dropped to 3-4 overall.

The Chiefs, who upped their record to 4-4, opened up with a 20-5 lead in the first quarter and extended the margin to 35-13 at halftime.

"We were looking to work on our normal defense and force them into some bad shots," said Canton coach Rob Neu, whose team strangled the Falcons with its man-to-man defense.

Neu's offensive plan worked well, too, and that is borne out by the scoring totals of senior forward Karen Boluch and sophomore center Susan Ferko, the game's leading scorers. Boluch had 17 points to go with 15 rebounds, and Ferko tossed in 16 points.

"Offensively, we really wanted to score inside, and the nice thing is we did that," Neu said.

The Chiefs, 3-0 in the Western Lakes, had four players in double figures with Amanda Bell adding 11 points and Heather Miller 10.

Farmington had its best quarter following

halftime (11 points), but Canton won going away with a 19-2 margin in the finale.

It was a particularly frustrating night for the Falcons, who were minus two players, including one starter, for disciplinary reasons and two others due to illness.

"It was hard to get them fired up for this game when half your players aren't there," Fair said. "We showed a little fire in the third, but it was not enough. It was too late."

"I think it would have been a different story if we had all our girls. Not necessarily with us taking the victory, but not (losing) by such a huge score."

Stacy Swanderski led Farmington with eight points and seven rebounds, and Kelli Koss added six points. The Falcons are 1-3 in the league.

SALEM 80, HARRISON 12: The contest was a definite mismatch with state-ranked Plymouth Salem coasting past winless Harrison.

The Rocks, who improved to 4-0 in the

league and 7-1 overall, distributed most of their points among five players in double figures.

Center Barb Krug led with 18 points, Dana Head scored 13 and Keri McBride netted 12. Jill Estey and Shelley Bohlen, who had a game-high eight rebounds, added 10 apiece.

Head also chalked up seven steals and 10 assists. Estey six and eight, respectively. Salem outscored the Hawks 28-17.

Leslie Devine had six points and five rebounds for Harrison, which trailed 35-7 at halftime and 57-8 after three quarters. The Hawks are 0-4 and 0-7.

The Rocks, who rolled over two Lakes Division opponents last week, have a big game today when they play at division foe Westland John Glenn, also 2-0 in the Lakes and 6-1 overall.

"Those games are behind us, and we want to step out and play well against John Glenn," Salem coach Fred Thomann said. "They've been playing well, too."

## Farmington lands 5th at invitational

The competition was a little too steep for Farmington's boys cross country team to win its second invitational in as many weeks Saturday.

The Falcons, who captured top honors in the Scholcraft meet Sept. 19, were fifth behind a quartet of state powers in the Royal Oak Shrine Invitational.

Birmingham Brother Rice, ranked No. 1 in Class A, was first with 41 points, No. 5 Milford Lakeland second (76), No. 2 Redford Catholic Central third (97) and No. 8 Milford fourth (108). The Falcons had 148 points.

"The four ahead of us are all ranked in the top eight in the state," Farmington coach Jerry Young said. "We figured we'd be lucky to beat any of them."

BRANDON London was among the meet's top performers, finishing ninth with a 16:55 time. Matt Walter was 30th (17:24), Brad Moore 33rd (17:26) and Rob Holloway 34th (17:27). Paul Brandt, who was 42nd at 17:50, ran his best time of the season.

"We need some help up front," Young said. "We've got Brandon, but we need somebody else with those low numbers."

Farmington was still missing Steve Quenneville and Ron Smedley, and one wonders if the Falcons might have fared better with them.

"You hope so," Young said. "Those are tough teams to deal with, and I don't know if we could have picked up 40 points with the two kids who were missing."

"Hopefully, later in the season we'll have a shot at those teams, but right now we're not ready. Still, we ran a pretty good meet."

Pete Galea, with an assist from Kurt Will, scored two minutes into the game, and Harrison held the Spartans scoreless the rest of the way.

"We played them real tough," Bruchan said. "I was real happy with the outcome."

"Defense has been our strong point this year. With two center-backs injured, we have to really work on defense. We have to be a defensive team, because we don't have much punch up front."

Harrison's Craig Bailey is sidelined with a knee injury, and Thierry Bersot suffered broken ribs in a recent game.

"We've always been a defensive team — and even more so without those two," Bruchan said.

Gary Wegner was outstanding in goal to hold a potent opponent to one score. The Hawks are 2-3-1 in the league, 6-3-1 overall.

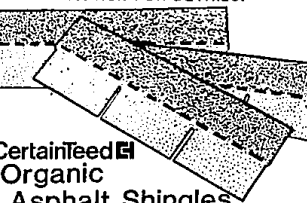
