FOR KURZEJA, there's the idea that he does not need to be commended for doing what he enjoys.

A former hospital corpsman in the Navy, Kurzeja received training in life saving before joining the Farmington Hills Fire Department.

It was that training that allowed him to remain calm during Christopher's birth.

"I like what I do, and I like coming into work," he said. "I like to

give 110 percent, and I'm going to continue doing that."

But there is no suppressing the boyish grin that spreads across his face when pressed for further details of his award.

"It's nice," he reluctantly admitted. "OK, it's great to have your peers nominate you for something they think you've done well."

A full-time firefighter and part-time student, Kurzeja wants to advance either in the department or work in private industry. Either way, he said, he'll continue to use his training as a firefighter.

Golf course must be built on schedule

course, Biassell said.

Work progress will be checked and if developers do not meet the schedule of improvements, additional permits may be withheld, according to the approved schedule.

If the developers want to speed up construction of the multiple units, the proposal requires that permits for the final 200 units will not be issued until the golf course is in playing condition, even if it is before the three-year deadline.

Though the city's open space policy requires the establishment of an escrow account to cover 150 percent of the total cost of improvements, it will not be required for the golf

course, Biassell said in his report. THAT'S BECAUSE the golf course is in addition to the regular open space and because golf course construction is expensive, requiring a large escrow account. In addition, the provision withholding permits on the last 200 multiple units until the course is completed "ensures that the golf course would be completed in its entirety before these units could be built," Biassell said in his report.

The city, Biassell continued, also does not want to be placed in a position of completing the golf course if developers default on the agreement.

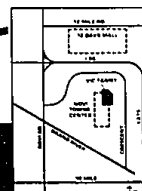
