For most of his life in a town where we have to drag out a television weatherman to fill a table of weel-known celebrities. Henry Ford I was always the one we could point to when we tried to explain what this city is all about.

By now, the eulogies are about over, even the ones that belatedly noticed that, despite the way his neck never quite fit into an opening-night tus, Ford's name seemed to be on the check for about everything that passes for culture in his Paris of southeastern lower Michigan. The seranable to say nice things about Ford seems to have been led by the folks who had been kitking him in the shins for the past loyers, even while he eased the company that was his life into a shape that allowed it to flourish on its own without him.

HE HAS been admired for saving Ford from seoundrels at the end of World War II, envied or childed for a somewhat rocky sideline as a ladies' man, characterized as autocratic, earthy, sometimes overbearing or even erratic.

Had we thought a bit, we might have questioned why any company ruled with an iron hand, by someone allegedly defensive about his own power, seemed to have more than its share of tough, independent, articulate executives over the years, including a labor boss who rolled into the executive garage his first week on the job on a motorcycle. Or why Ford's "mistakes" seemed to work themselves out — even when he replaced Lee Iacocca with the bland organizational abilities of a Phil Caldweil.



GIVEN HIS treatment of the press, which went beyond disdain or distrust to a kind of whimsical fooling around, it's not surprising that he never managed to get the record

never managed to get the record straight.
At least twice, he spilled major news stories while chatting with a reporter in a public rest room. As easily, he would clam up in a sched-uled interview Hetiring, he never turned off the paper shredder, even in the presence of a would-be biographer. As a result, we never got the real

Ford, but we seemed to need some-body flesh and blood to offset the faceless power of the three corpor-rate bureaucracies that dominate most people's lives around here, and he did some job as the symbol of the big industrialist in charge. He was the postwar generation's Big Guy, spiritual leader of the en-trepreneurs who turned everything from wheel covers to tollet scan into personal fortunes overright. He never sweated in his family's plants, but he seemed born with the kind of judgment that gets honed in an in-

dustry where a bad move can lose you a hand or dump a puddle of molten steel on the plant floor. It was a generation that misspent its wealth, but also spread it around. The big money from Ductroi invented the shopping center and bought a large piece of southern California, while the small paychecks redecorated basemest. To understand tax law, divide income into 3 parts

Of all the many questions people ask me regarding financial planning, none matches the interest and confusion that surround tax planning in general and tax shelters in particular. This column deals with tax planning under the new tax law.

Income, losses defined

The accompanying chart presents the three major categories of income under the new tax law: active in-come, portfolio income and passive

come, portfolio income and passive income.

Until 1986, portfolio losses (losses from the sale of stocks and bonds) and passive losses (tax losses generated by tax shelters) were freely used to reduce active or salary income. In fact, this was the main basis of tax planning.

Under the new fam, however, losses and income from the three calegories don't mix. Consequently, tax shelter and portfolio losses can't be used to offset salary income.

A passive activity is one that in-volves the conduct of any trade or business in which the taxpayer does not materially participate. Any rental activity (with one ex-ception) is a passive activity, regard-less of whether the taxpayer materi-

ally participates. For a taxpayer to be considered materially participating in a trade or business activity, he must be involved in the operations of that activity on a "regular, continuous, and substantial basis". Interestingly, limited participations are treated as interests in a passive activity without regard to whether the taxpayer materially participates in that activity. Portfolio income is simply defined as interest, dividends, royalties and gains from the sale of property held for investment (and not held under passive activity). Can laxes be reduced?

The answer is yes. For instance, current and future taxes on active income can be reduced by contributions to qualified plans and insurance-related investments.






