

Botsford plans 'Broadway in Farmington'

If you're planning a visit to the "Big Apple" this year, you can continue the experience in Farmington Hills.

The 151-year-old Botsford Inn on Grand River will recreate "Broadway in Farmington" for travelers. For three days, guests can submerge themselves in the excitement of the

"Great White Way." Its theater, its show-biz and all the magic and glitz. Designed for the traveler with limited time and money but eager for a weekend mini-vacation, the idyllic venture opens with a welcome reception reminiscent of a Manhattan bistro. Dressed for a theater evening, guests can feast, then sub-

merge themselves in a show that's played repeat performances on 42nd Street. "The Dining Room" is a lively show of continuous action performed by a professional Detroit dinner-theater company, Janus Productions.

After breakfast Saturday, guests will be encouraged to study their

guide to "shopping The Glitz Strips" in Farmington Hills and their neighbors — Bloomfield, West Bloomfield, Birmingham and Livonia.

It's a party mood that is required, along with "putting on the ritz" type garb, for the dinner and nightclub

cabaret show Saturday evening. Nancy Gurwin, singer/actress, will showcase the musical production "To Broadway With Love." It features a surprise element.

Brunch on Sunday at the Botsford Inn will leave guests with just enough energy to wander through the many historic rooms. Once a stagecoach stop and tavern, the inn was restored in 1924 by auto baron Henry Ford and his wife, Clara, who met

at the weekly dances held in the ballroom. While operating the inn, they placed many of their own antiques throughout.

The package includes champagne and crumpets waiting for guests in their rooms. It is available Jan. 16-18; Feb. 19-20-21 and March 18-19-20. It will be repeated midweek in June, July and August 1988. Cost of the package per person is \$179 with tax and tip extra.

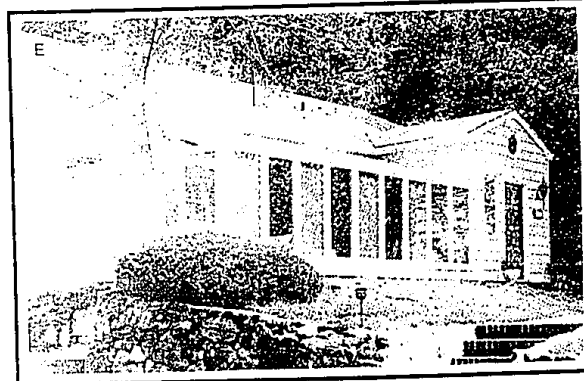
