Beware

Flu, pneumonia: they can kill

It's flu and pneumonia season. For many Americans this is a matter of life and death.

People in certain high-risk categories, such as those age 65 and older, and those suffering from chronic lung or heart disease, are in greatest danger from flu and its complications, according to the American Lung Association of Southeast Michigan, the Christmas Seal People.

The reason is that complications of flu, usually just a moderately serious illness in healthy children and adults, can be life-threatening and even fatal for those at high risk. The most common and serious adoption of influenza is bacteria be so weakened from flu or from underlying disease that its error in certain course from flu and pneumonia—about 80-90 percent of these deaths were among high-risk individuals.

"Yet, this number could be sub-stantially reduced if people in high-risk groups would get their flu shots and their pneumococcal pneumonia vaccination," said Kattleen Robin-son of the American Lung Associa-tion of Southeast Michigan, (The pneumococcal pneumonia vaccine protects against one common form of pneumonia.)

THOSE AT greatest risk from flu and pneumonla include: older adults, especially those over 6% adults and children who have chronic illness such as long-term lung or heart problems, kidney disease or disciscional control of the cont

According to Robinson, flu and pneumonia combined have ranked as

the sixth leading cause of death in the United States every year since 179, in 1985, the 94 million reported episodes of flu were responsible for 380 million restricted activity days and 1805 million sixth bed days. "That's where an sixth bed days, "That's where an expension of the effort to reach people did this in-formation," she continued.

The best time for vaccination is well before mid-November. This allows time for lots of anticolate to build up before the peak flu season. Influenza shots need the season. The pneumococcal pneumonia vaccine, however, is a once-than litetime shot, and is reimbursable by Medicare.
