Spina to speak

The Art of Poland Associates will present "An Evening with Tony Spina and His Photographs of Pope John Paul II," including photographs from the recent trips of John Paul II to Poland and the United States on Sunday, Nov. 8.

A champagne reception and viewing of the exhibit begins at 5:30 p.m., followed by a 6:30 p.m. dinner and slide presentation by Spina in the Prentiss Court.

Spina, a photojournalist, is the recipient of over 450 awards and honors. In 1985, he received the Sprague Memorial Award from the National Press Photographers Association, the highest honor in photojournalism.

He is an author of a weekly photocolumn, which is syndicated in approximately 180 newspapers in the U.S. and Canada.

Spina's assignments have included photographing four popes and eight presidents, including coverage of all pilgrimages of Pope John Paul II to Poland. While in Poland, he also photographed the people, countryside and treasures of this country.

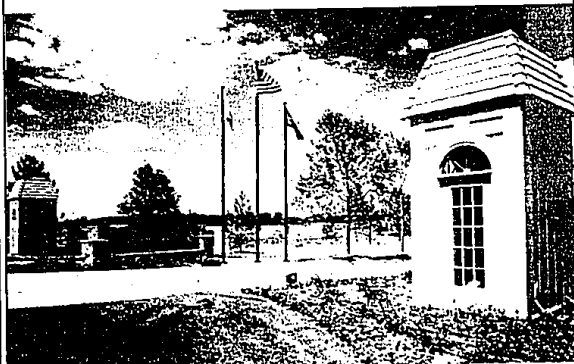

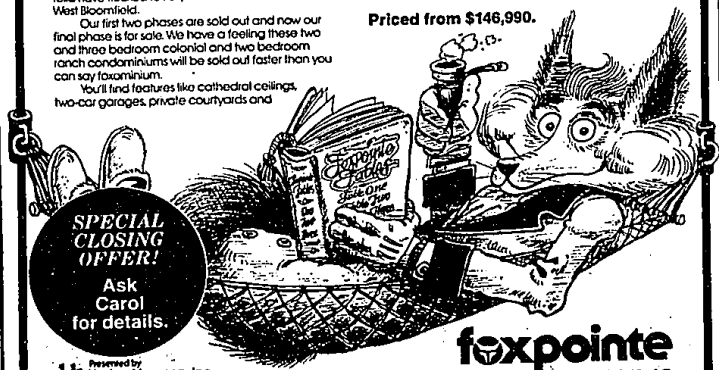
