The three Farmington City Council candidates and one of nine Farmington Hills candidates were interviewed during cable television's coverage of local elections.

Though cable staff expected a few more Farmington Hills candidates to participate in the live coverage on election night Nov 3, their absence didn't greatly affect the show's success, sald Todd Whitman, Southwestern Oakland Cable Commission production specialist.
