

100 artists in Temple show

Birmingham Temple's 15th annual Art Show and Sale will feature more than 100 artists. Monte Nagler, recent recipient of the 1987 artist in residence award by the Farmington Area Arts Commission, will be on hand, displaying his photography.

Nagler, a U-M graduate with a master's in business, switched careers in the 1970s to become a full-time freelance photographer. His photographs are included in collections of the Detroit Institute of Arts, Brooklyn Museum, Center for Creative Photography and others.

Nagler teaches photography at Cranbrook, Birmingham Community House, Farmington Com-

munity Center and Southfield cultural arts department.

Nagler's series, "Back Roads of Europe," taken in eight European countries, was recently shown at Somerset Mall. He has traveled the globe for material and has expanded his subject matter from landscapes to still lifes and people.

Another unusual artist in the Temple Art Show is Netherlands-based doll maker, Ingrid Dijkers. Her 2-foot-tall dolls are a blend of mythology, folklore and imagination. Head, hands and feet are stonecast, with costumes fashioned of fabrics and trim gleaned from markets and fairs throughout Europe and the United States.

Guests may meet these artists, and all the others, at the preview 6-11 p.m. Friday, Nov. 20. The show, co-sponsored by WQRS, FM 105, will continue 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Saturday and Sunday, Nov. 21 and 22. Admission is free until noon each day and \$2 thereafter.

Orchestra shows spirit

ate acoustics, which was also the case a few weeks earlier when the Central Philharmonic of China also opened the program with a Verdi overture. Possibly, visiting orchestras should be warned about the sensitive acoustics.

The cellist in the Dvorak concerto was Truls Oltedalbeck Mork who, at 26, is recognized as one of Scandinavia's leading musicians. This was the second chance this season for local audiences to hear this masterful work. The first was the last program with the Detroit Symphony Orchestra before the present work stoppage.

Mork was so impressive with his performance that he was called for repeated bows with the prolonged applause and standing ovations. He

played the Bourée from Bach's Cello Suite in C Major as an encore.

Jansons was most convincing with the Shostakovich 5th Symphony, which is the most popular of the composer's 15 symphonies. His contrast of tempo was very effective. In the final movement, for example, the contrast between the first, festive part and the slower tempo was more pronounced than the DSO's a few years ago under Maxim Shostakovich, the composer's son.

Orchestral encores are somewhat unusual, but the Oslo Philharmonic presented two - the Valse Triste by Sibelius and the scene of Tybalt's death from "Romeo and Juliet" by Prokofiev. If Norway is perceived as a cold country in terms of climate, this program proved that it has a lot of warmth to offer.

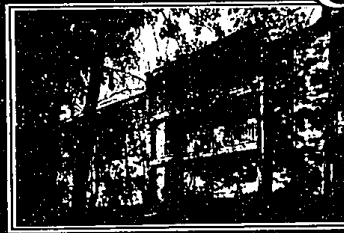

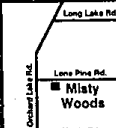
