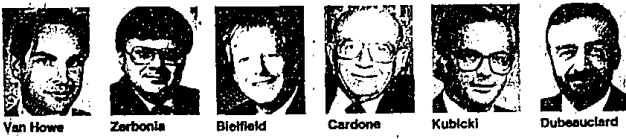

Hudson's to open more

Dayton Hudson Corp. plans to open 25 Target stores, 15 Mervyn's stores and three Lechmere stores in 1988.

The new units will bring total stores to more than 600 by the end of 1988 and will increase retail space by 4 million square feet. By year's end 1988, the corporation's retail space will total more than 61 million square feet.

A total capital investment of approximately \$600 million to be invested in new stores, distribution centers, remodeling and technology.

Over the past two years, Dayton Hudson has invested \$2 billion to open 165 stores; 94 Target stores, 51 Mervyn's stores, 14 Lechmere stores and six Brantford's stores. The additions increased retail space by more than 14 million square feet.
