# Privately run jail 'great idea' — Murphy

Aurphy is cheering on efforts of a
Dearborn businessman to build a private fail for misdemeanor offenders.

"It's a great idea. He's going at it
systematically in light of the attorney general's opinion." Murphy said.

Chip Acty, president of a tool
company, is proposing to build a

"WHETHER MICHIGAN does it this time or another time — it's still a better way," said Murphy, a Re-publican who advocates contracting government work to business when-ever it will cut cost.

"It (Acey's plan) doesn't take away from the sherif's responsibility. The sheriff still sets the standards," Mur-oby said.

"We've talked to Chip Acey. I don't see a problem" with the practi-cal side of operating a jail, Murphy

Under Murphy's proposal, the
counties would pay the private contractor on a per-diem basis. Several
states — Tonnessee, Florida, Minnesota, California and Texas among
them — reportedly already have privately-operated jails.

"IT'S A tremendous savings in the long run," Murphy said.
"It costs us as much to house a drunk driver for six or eight hours as it does for a felony criminal," Murphy said.

It is these persons Acey is proposing to bouse in a privately-built and operated jail.

Attorney General Frank J. Kelley's opinion said jails may not be privately operated though they may be privately built. And Wayne County Sheriff Robert Ficano opposes privately operated jails.

FRANK WILKERSON, Acey's lawyer, said, "We've already started discussing this with legislators." He will seek to change the law to allow private firms to operate jails. Wilkerson was administrator of the Wayne County Jall in the days when William Lucas was sherif. Wilkerson also sought the 1985 Democratic aomination for county executive. He is now in private legal practice.

But Robert Fleano, current Wayne County sheriff, opposes privately-operated jails.

"There have been too many questions that have never been answered. What happens If it goes bankrupt? What about llability? The U.S. Supreme Court says civil rights violations cannot be delegated to private industry — so If there is an offense,


