# Miniature Makers': Santa's kind of place

At this time of the year when every-one else is thinking big, Clarissa Goad is having a ball with small.

Goad — Criss to her friends — is the owner of Miniature Makers' Workshop in Birmingham where, of course, everything is downsized but very

An accomplished jeweler and metalsmith in her own right, Goad's workshop caters to the largest adult collectible hobby in the United States by selling intricately crafted miniature furniture and accessories, dollhouses, and the supplies to build and furnish dollhouses, accessories, and diorama (room settings). Most are made to a scale of one inch to one foot.

Goad also handles items such as Victorian dollhouses, tiny canopy beds, Sheraton sofas, wicker rockers, brass candlesticks, Oriental rugs, draperies, flowers and silver bowls. Prices range from less than a dollar for miniaaccessories to \$500 for a finished dollhouse.

THE MINIATURE Makers' Workshop also offers winter, spring and fall classes and workshops that are held at the store. Electrical wiring of dollhouses, constructing room settings, carving furniture, making accessories of all kinds, and dressing special dolls are some of the types of instruction available.

There is also an opportunity for miniaturists to participate in a free open workshop each Friday from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. to work on personal projects.

Goad, who purchased the workshop in 1984, is a lifelong resident of Birmingham. She is a former president of the Birmingham Junior League and is active with the Birmingham Bloom-field Art Association, the Cranbrook Art Museum, the Village Club and Christ Church Cranbrook.

She is a member of the WeeBees, the local chapter of the National Association of Miniature Enthusiasts (NAME) and the International Guild of Miniature Artists (IGMA).
