Orion Oaks park targets handicapped

Orion Oaks, the undeveloped courty park, will be something different. The ninth Oakland County park will have much of its area reserved for "special populations" — the handicapped, church groups, band camps, school groups and possibly corporate groups.

The rest will be for "day use" — plenicking, lishing and cross-country sking.

"You're going in the right direction," said Jack Olsen, a member of the nine-member parks and recreation commissioner from Huntington Woods.

ALL-YEAR cabins and a pool are strong possibilities, according to a consultant's preliminary plans. The parks commission last week spent more than an hour listening to, outzing and giving feedback to its consultant — Schmidt-Copeland and Associates of Cleveland.

Greg Copeland of the firm has advised other parks agencies, in Grand Rapids and across the court, on parks for the handicapped. The Oaktand panel approved motion designating Orion Oaks for "special populations and limited day use."

tions really were interested in the facility.

Orion Oaks covers 927 acres north of Pontiac. It is reached by the Jo-lyn Road exit from I-75.

It was once part of a 2,400-acrparcel owned by Chrysler Corp. Osiland County and the Michigan Upartment of Natural Resources acquired it a few years ago.
